# European Contract Law: harmonization issues and future developments

This course has been sponsored by the University of Brescia, as an essential part of the internationalization programme. It is a highly specialised training course, addressing undergraduate students, PhD Students and Practitioners (Lawyers, Notary Publics) who want to face in depth the essential aspects of European Contract Law.

This course will develop in two modules both based on the active participation of attendees.

**Part I** will be devoted to the presentation of the contractual sources of European Contract Law, presentation of the different contracts and of the different legal obligations imposed for consumer contracts, presentation of the “so called” common rules of consumer contracts. Within the frame of this module, focus will be on the case law of the Court on the definition of consumers and on UCP and UCT directives. Part of the module will be dedicated to cases study.

**Part II** will deal with Individual and Collective Redresses, in Europe and France, and the with the analysis of the main European Court of Justice case law. Within the frame of this module, focus will be on the case law of the ECJ on the *ex officio* powers of judges, on the Schrems II case and on the EU commission’s proposal on collective redress.
